

POLICE JURY MEETING – September 2, 2020

The Allen Parish Police Jury met in regular session at the Police Jury Administration Building, Oberlin, Louisiana, September 2, 2020 at the hour of 6:30 p.m.

Present: Anthony Hebert, Allen Courville, John Strother, Ruffin George, Jr., Creig Vizena, Chad Sanders. Absent: Heath Ardoin

Motion by Mr. Vizena seconded by Mr. Strother and carried to go into session.

The Lord's Prayer was said followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Recognized Joel Johnson for an update on the roads. Mr. Johnson stated that clearing the roads were a top priority after Hurricane Laura passed. Mr. Johnson and the Jurors commended the road crew workers for their hard work and the citizens of the Parish for helping as well.

Recognized Jacob Dillehay to discuss the Debris Removal contract. Requests for proposals were released for debris pickup contractors and debris monitoring contractors to submit to the Parish proposals that include pricing to come in and pickup storm debris of public right of ways. That includes outside of city limits and inside of city limits. Each municipality will have the option to enter in a Joint Service Agreement with the Parish and have the Parish's contractor assist them with clean up. We are following the guidelines to meet the qualifications to be reimbursed by FEMA. Bids are due by 4pm today. The bids will be reviewed on Thursday and Friday. The bids will be presented along with the estimates and costs and will have a discussion for awarding at our next meeting (9/8/20).

Recognized Keith Strother, Allen Parish Mosquito Control, regarding FEMA funded aerial mosquito spraying around the Parish.

Motion by Mr. Strother seconded by Mr. Vizena and carried to adjourn the meeting.
